This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondents no. 1 to 3 for providing police protection to the petitioners on the plea that they have got married on 22.12.2014 against the wishes of respondents no. 4 to 8, the relatives/family members of the petitioner no.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners only prays that the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, with whom the petitioners have already moved the representation on 23.12.2014 may be directed to consider their representation as per law. Both the petitioners are present today in the Court and have been identified by learned counsel for the

petitioners.

In view of the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting anything on the legality of marriage between the petitioners, respondent no. 2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is hereby directed to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 23.12.2014 for the purpose of satisfying himself whether there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners and then to take the appropriate action as per law for providing the police protection to the petitioners.

A copy of this order be communicated to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar along with copy of Annexure P-4.

The present petition stands disposed of.
