Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he does not wish to press his petition for grant of regular bail to the petitioner and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn. However, he limits his prayer for grant of interim bail to the petitioner for one week on account of the wedding of his sister fixed for 24.06.2015. He has annexed invitation card (Annexure P-3).

Keeping in view the aforesaid fact and the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for about three months, the petitioner is granted interim bail for one week from 23.06.2015 to 01.07.2015. The petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate Roopnagar. He is directed to surrender before the jail authorities on or before 01.07.2015 by 5.00 PM.
