Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.513 dated 18.09.2014, registered under Sections 148, 149, 283, 341, 506, 382, 435, 216, 325 of IPC along with Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act and Sections 3, 33, 89 of SC/ST Act, at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 18.06.2015, directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on

interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer in connection with abovesaid case FIR.

Learned State counsel stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for interrogation.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 18.06.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition disposed of accordingly.
