AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No. 4 to 10.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. Petitioner No.1 in support of her age proof, has placed on record her duly sworn in affidavit(Annexure P-1) wherein she has deposed that she is not aware of her date of birth but her year of birth is 1991. Petitioner No.2 in support of his age proof has also placed on record extract of his ration card (Annexure P-2) which shows his age as 18 years in 2006. Petitioner No. 1 is stated to have already moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur,

Punjab for protecting her life and liberty and that of her husband Jugnu i.e. petitioner No.2. Copy of the representation is annexed as Annexure P-5.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, Punjab-respondent No.2 to take an appropriate action on the said representation.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be given dasti to learned counsel for the petitioners on payment of usual charges.
