MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 84 dated 30.5.2015 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 12 of Passport Act, 1967 at Police Station Siwan, District Kaithal.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that a false complaint has been registered by her mother and the brother to grab the property. The passport, which had been taken in the petitioner's name by her divorced husband, had given the name which the husband used to call her and the subsequent passport had been taken in her own name and there was no fraud committed in the passport taken in her real name.

Noticing the aforesaid facts this Court had granted interim protection to the petitioner vide its order dated 18.6.2015 subject to the compliance of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner has since joined investigation to the satisfaction

of the Investigating Officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from SI Raj Phul.

Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and also the fact that dispute seems to be by a disgruntled mother, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 18.6.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
