Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.181 dated 16.10.2014 under Sections 406/420 IPC registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

This Court vide order dated 18.6.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and compliance of Section 438(2) CrPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 18.6.2015, petitioner has joined

investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Baljinder Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 18.6.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
