Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0025 dated 5.1.2015 under Section 506 IPC registered at Police Station Hisar Civil Lines, District Hisar.

This Court vide order dated 18.6.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining the investigation and compliance of provisions of Section 438(2) CrPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 18.6.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial

interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 18.6.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
