Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.88 dated 01.07.2014, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

Following order was passed by this Court on 22.06.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are pertaining to the year 2011 whereas FIR has been lodged on 01.07.2014 after a lapse of almost three years. He further submits that during this period there have been financial dealings between the petitioner and the complainant and at no stage the complainant has made any grievance with the regard to the allegations levelled in the FIR.

Adjourned to 27.07.2015.

In the meanwhile, it is ordered that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer subject to the conditions laid down under section 438 sub section 2 clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the respondent No.3 has opposed the petition.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Sardara Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

During the course of arguments, it has transpired that parties have filed complaints against each other.

Hence, it would be just and expedient to confirm the interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 22.06.2015.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 22.06.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
