Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.706 dated 11.10.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Jhajjar.

Following order was passed by this Court on 07.07.2015:-

“Mr. Jagjeet Beniwal, Advocate, has filed his power of attorney on behalf of the complainant, same is taken on record.

This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.706 dated 11.10.2014 registered under Sections 419/420/467/468/471 IPC at Police Station Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that

parties have compromised the matter.

Adjourned to 18.8.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall, however, join investigation as and when called for and they will also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Ranbir Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 07.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
