The petitioners have approached this Court for seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 6 and for providing them adequate security and restraining respondent Nos. 4 to 6 from interfering in their married life. It is alleged that the petitioners are major and have got married on 12.6.2015 as per marriage certificate dated 12.6.2015 (Annexure P-1) at Shri Krishna Mandir (Regd.) Haveli Kalan, Ropar and the photographs of the ceremony are attached as Annexures P-2. The petitioners have also alleged that they apprehend danger to their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

Before coming to this Court, the petitioners had also moved an application to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar (respondent No.2) by way of application dated 13.6.2015 (Annexure P-5) for providing them security.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, it is directed that in case an application (Annexure P-5) is moved to the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned, he will look into the same and if the facts stated in the application are found to be correct and any danger to the lives and liberty of the petitioners is found, he shall provide necessary protection to them.

With these directions, this petition is disposed of.
