The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions for transfer of investigation pertaining to case F.I.R No.89 dated 2.6.2013 under sections 336, 324, 323, 427, 148 and 149 I.P.C and sections 25, 27, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda, to an independent agency or outside the district.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Bhalla Singh would apprise the Court that investigation in the case has since been completed and the challan was presented on 11.12.2014. Concededly, even the charges have thereafter been framed.

Faced with such a situation, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to raise all pleas as may be available to the petitioner before the Trial Court, strictly in accordance with law.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
