FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.152 dated 7.4.2015 under Section 20 NDPS, Act at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat.

The allegations against the petitioner-Ramesh in this regular bail application are that on 7.4.2015 he was found in possession of 500 grams of charas placed in his residential premises. The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is behind the bars since 7.4.2015 and that the same is a non-commercial quantity is squarely conceded at bar by the learned State counsel.

In view thereof and keeping in view that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and that no purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars and that the report of analysis is yet to be received, without adverting anything

on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
