AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.5 to 8.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 02.06.1996 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Middle Standard Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 05.10.1993.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to treat this petition as representation and take an appropriate action on it.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
