This order will dispose of an application for grant of bail filed by Baljinder Singh, who in connivance with his co-accused Sukhwinder Singh duped the complainant to purchase the property of original owner of Sukhjot Kaur, fraudulently representing that the property belongs to Mahinder Pal Singh who is a non-existence person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not even an attesting witness of the sale deed.

There are clear allegations of the petitioner having connived with co-accused Sukhwinder Singh in selling the property of a lady on the basis of fictitious registered sale deed in favour of Mahinder Pal Singh.

In view of dismissal of application of co-accused Sukhwinder Singh, no ground is made out to grant bail to the petitioner also.

Dismissed.
