This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 21 dated 06.05.2015 registered at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib, under Sections 324, 354, 326 IPC.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would not press this petition and would surrender before the Illaqa Magistrate but a direction should be issued to the Magistrate to decide the application for regular bail, to be moved by the petitioner, expeditiously.

In the circumstances, it is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the Illaqa Magistrate within two weeks and moves an application for regular bail, the same be decided by the Magistrate expeditiously but in any case within four days on merits.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
