Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.318 dated 23.10.2014, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added subsequent), registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mohendergarh.

This Court vide order dated 19.6.2015, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to their joining investigation and compliance of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 19.6.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Balwan Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 19.6.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
