By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.23, dated 14.05.2015, registered under Sections 326, 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is a case of version and cross version. In pursuance of the order dated 02.07.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition stands allowed.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
