The petitioners have approached this Court for seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect their lives and liberty from respondents No.4 to 11 and for providing them adequate security and restraining respondents No. 4 to 11 from interfering in their married life. It is alleged that the petitioners are major and have got married on 15.6.2015 at Vedic Hindu Sabha (Regd.), J-102, Sec-9, Vijay Nagar, Ghaziabad which was registered by them as per marriage registration certificate (Annexure P-3) issued by the Registrar, Hindu Marriages, Sub District Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh. The petitioners have also alleged that they apprehend danger to their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 11.

Before coming to this Court, the petitioners had also moved an application to the Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (respondent No.2) by way of application dated 15.6.2015 (Annexure P-4) for providing them security.
