Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.64 dated 07.03.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, by way of settlement agreement dated 19.09.2015, which is available on record. He undertakes to comply with all the terms and conditions of settlement arrived at between the parties.

The abovesaid statement made and undertaking given by the petitioner has not been denied by learned counsel for the complainant as well as learned counsel for the State.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed and the order dated 06.07.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

It is further clarified that if the petitioner-husband backs out from the terms and conditions of settlement agreement dated 19.09.2015 arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, respondent-complainant/wife shall be at liberty to take appropriate steps against the petitioner-husband, in accordance with law.

Disposed of, accordingly.
