The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.198 dated 30.04.2015, under Sections 498-A and 406 of IPC, registered with Police Station Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

The husband is praying for anticipatory bail in a case filed by the wife due to marital discord.

This Court, vide order dated 23.06.2015, had granted interim bail and the parties were thereafter referred before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court.

As per the report received from the Mediation Centre, the parties have arrived at a mutual settlement, vide written deed dated 12.08.2015, which is at **Flag-A.**

Learned Counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Kuldeep Singh, concede that in view of the petitioner having joined the investigation and the deed of compromise/settlement dated 12.08.2015, present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
