Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 203, dated 30.05.2015, under Sections 354-B, 452, 341, 323, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh.

There are allegations against the petitioner that on 14.05.2015, petitioner entered the house of the complainant when her parents were away for some work and tried to outrage modesty of the complainant. Thereafter, on 16.05.2015, the petitioner threatened the complainant that he would kill her and her family members and would get

her mother removed from the job.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

A bare perusal of the FIR reveals that petitioner entered the house of the complainant and tried to outrage modesty of the +1 Class minor girl. The allegations apparently appear to be serious.

In view of above, petitioner does not deserve concession of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
