Counsel for the petitioner submits that the mother-in-law of deceased Meenakshi was granted bail by this Court on 12.05.2015. It is further submitted that there was no suicide note and the allegations against the petitioner and his mother were that they taunted the deceased for her dark complexion and for not bearing a child.

Counsel for the State submits that though the mother-in-law has been granted bail, but the husband should not be granted the similar relief as he had greater responsibility towards his wife and should have rather dissuaded his mother from extending torture to his wife by making remarks about her complexion and infertility, if it was there. He rather sided with his mother in extending torture to Meenakshi.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.
