Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.61 dated 30.09.2011 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B, registered at Police Station Phase 8, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are Panchayat Secretaries and they are not the persons who have tampered the alleged transfer order.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head-constable-Gurmeet Singh states that apart from the other information, specific signatures of the petitioners are required in the

present case.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are not the main accused in the present case, they are allowed anticipatory bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

Petition is disposed of.
