Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case arising from FIR No.30 dated 21.04.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka, under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that name of petitioner does not figure in the FIR. He further contends that the petitioner has got a case registered against Pawan Singh and Shinder

Singh under Sections 376, 500, 506, 509 and 384 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 67-A of Information and Technology Act, in 2012.

Per contra, learned State counsel vehemently opposes the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner and contends that fraud has been allegedly committed by the petitioner and others. The name of petitioner figures during the investigation of the case.

I have considered the rival contentions of learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the nature of offence and involvement of gang in such like frauds, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required. CRM-M-19164-2015 moved by co-accused Balkaran Singh has also been dismissed by this Court vide order dated 01.07.2015. To blow the lid off alleged fraud, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

No ground for anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.
