Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.78 dated 25.05.2015, registered under Sections 411, 414, 489A, 489B, 489C of IPC, Sections 21, 22, 61/85 of NDPS Act and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act and Section 3 of Passport Act, 1920 at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is vague and false allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. Learned counsel also submits that the name of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR which was lodged on a secret information received from a person.

I have considered the contentions raised by leaned counsel for the petitioner.

There are certain allegations against the petitioner that he is indulging with other co-accused in the narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances cases. Besides that, fake currency as well as ammunitions were also recovered from the accused party. It is also alleged that they all were in contact with smugglers of Pakistan and used to import heroin and other intoxicants from Pakistan to the State of Punjab, especially to the area adjoining Amritsar district. There are serious allegations against the petitioner and otherwise also, the prevailing situation with regard to NDPS cases is very alarming and in such cases, the custodial interrogation is a necessity.

No ground for grant of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
