This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under sections 148, 149, 302 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act and section 216/120-B IPC added later on at Police Station Jhajjar, vide FIR No.125 dated 23.02.2015.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Sumit Kumar, Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar. Same is taken on record.

Allegations in the FIR is that husband of the petitioner alongwith co-accused committed murder of one Anil. Stand of the petitioner is that neither she was present on the spot nor named in the FIR. Her name figured in the statement of relation of the deceased recorded under section 161 Cr.P.C. Petitioner has already been released on interim bail as it was found that she was in custody alongwith a four months old infant.

Keeping in view entire facts and circumstances of the case, the interim order dated June 29, 2015 is hereby made absolute. Trial court is, however, at liberty to impose such conditions upon the petitioner as it deems fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.
