Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.154 dated 22.03.2014 under Sections 15 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to press this petition and the same may be dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.

However, Superintendent of Police, Karnal is directed to look into the matter as to why the trial of this NDPS matter is being unduly delayed. There are some zimni orders available on record, which show that no PWs were present at the time of trial. He must ensure that no delay or any fault on the part of the prosecuting agency takes place.

Learned trial Court is also directed to expedite the trial.

Disposed of, accordingly.
