The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents Nos.2 and 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

It has been averred that the petitioner No.1 and 2 are major as they were born in 1992 and 1990, and copies of Aadhar Card of petitioner No.1 and Voter Card of petitioner No.2 to this effect are attached as Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively.

It has been submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 22.06.2015 according to Sikh rites at Gurudwara Shri Nanaksar Sahib Karor Kalan, Naya Gaon, Tehsil Kharar, Distirct SAS Nagar (Mohali). The marriage certificate and photographs of marriage are attached as Annexure P-3 and Annexure P-4(Colly.).

Private respondents No.4 to 6 are opposed to the marriage, as the petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 21.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Lata Singh v. State of U.P. And another, 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
