Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.22 dated 12.05.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Pathankot, District Pathankot, under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 25.06.2015, interim relief was granted to the petitioner for the purpose of exploring the possibility of settlement and it was directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer

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in connection with above-said case FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that parties have effected compromise and have also moved application under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Surender Kumar submits that compromise has been effected between the parties.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 25.06.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.

Complainant will be at liberty to approach this Court, if the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner is found to be incorrect.
