AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.125 dated 29.03.2015 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

The allegation is that the petitioner had tried to obtain container by using forged invoices of the complainant-company.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that at best it was

an attempt to defraud and that the petitioner has now been in custody for more than 4 months.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from S.I Om Parkash has accepted this fact.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
