Through the instant petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought directions to the respondents to provide adequate security to the petitioner, as the petitioner is a president of Gau Raksha Dal.

Petitioner is stated to have received threats to life at the hands of anti-social elements.

Notice of motion was issued in the case and in response thereto, a status report by way of affidavit of Piara Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, has been filed today in the Court on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. The contents of the affidavit reads as under:-

"1. That the deponent is filing short affidavit in form of reply. However, the deponent will file detailed reply, if directed by this Hon'ble Court.

2. That the petitioner Gauraksha Dal, A.C. Market, Rajpura Town, Distt. Patiala, through its president Satish Kumar son of Sh. Charan Dass, has been provided with security cover comprising of two PSOs(One from Armed Battalions & one from Punjab Home Guard.

3. That it is further respectfully submitted that the respondents may be given liberty

to carry out periodic assessments of threat perception in respect of the petitioner, and to accordingly increase/decrease or withdraw the security provided to the petitioner.”

In view of the status report by way of affidavit dated 03.03.2015 submitted by Sh. Piara Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Security Punjab, Chandigarh, the present petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
