Instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.5 dated 18.12.2012 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, F.S.1, Mohali, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 201, 120-B IPC and Section 13(1)(c)(d) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act wherein the petitioner has been cited as prosecution witness and has been summoned by way of non-bailable warrants by the trial Court vide order dated 04.06.2015 (Annexure P-1).

On 24.06.2015, the petitioner undertook to appear before the

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trial Court on the next date for her examination as prosecution witness.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of order dated 24.06.2015, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court as prosecution witness and her deposition has been recorded completely.
