Learned counsel for the appellant submits that despite his best efforts he has not been able to contact the appellant. A registered letter was sent to the appellant, which was received back with the endorsement of the postal authorities that Chander Kumar, appellant, has died. A copy of the letter and photocopy of the postal cover with report has been produced, which is taken on record.

It is an appeal against dismissal of the claim petition. In the absence of claimant, learned counsel for the appellant has expressed his inability to submit correct address of respondents no.2, 4 and 5. Without service of respondents no.2, 4 and 5, this appeal cannot be disposed of.

As such, this appeal is disposed of due to non-compliance of the order dated 12.01.2015. However, it may be got restored as and when the addresses of respondents no.2, 4 and 5 are furnished before the registry by the appellant or his legal heirs.
