This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.77 dated 25.05.2015 under Sections 406, 420, 473, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station PAU, Ludhiana.

The allegations against the petitioners and their co-accused are that they deceived the complainant party of an amount of ₹ 7,00,000/- on the pretext that they would be paid double the amount invested. Petitioner is in custody from 26.05.2015. The recovery of the amount has been effected. The co-accused has

already been granted bail. The learned State counsel submits that investigation is complete and the challan would be presented shortly.

The case is triable by the Magistrate.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the fact that the trial will take time in conclusion, the instant petition is allowed and petitioners-Gurmeet Singh and Kulwinder Singh be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Area Magistrate/trial Court.
