Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from respondent Nos.4 and 5. The petitioners assert that they are major and as there is no legal impediment, they have got married. They have already moved representation dated 21.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Nuh, Mewat, for protecting their life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that due to haste, age of petitioner No.2 has been wrongly typed as 01.05.2015 in Annexure P-

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2, in fact the same is 01.05.1981 as per photocopy of driving licence (Annexure P-2) in vernacular. He expresses regret for the same.

Instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach concerned police authorities for protection, as per instructions dated 21.02.2011 issued by the Home Department, Haryana, in this regard. Police authorities shall verify the facts. If required, petitioners will be provided adequate security.

In the meantime, petitioners shall not be arrested in this case. However, this will not prevent the concerned police authorities to proceed against the petitioners in accordance with law, if they are found involved in any other case. The police authorities shall also verify the facts with regard to age and antecedents of the petitioners.

It is made clear that this order is qua protection only and shall not be construed that the petitioners have contracted legal marriage. They have to prove legality of their marriage in appropriate proceedings.
