The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 112 dated 18.03.2015, registered under Sections 22/61/85 NDPS Act at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused Kewal had been granted bail. He has placed on record copy of the order dated 15.05.2015 passed by Special Court, Ludhiana. He further contends that recovery of 8 grams of heroine was not effected from the petitioner. The trial Court had rejected the earlier bail applications filed by the petitioner on the ground that there are 3-4 cases pending against the petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that trial is taking time, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
