RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from respondent No.4.

The petitioner, who is a senior citizen, had one son and four daughters. His son has expired about 20 years back. Gurbachan Singh-respondent No.4 is son-in-law of the petitioner. Grievance of the petitioner is that respondent No.4 has taken a sum of Rs.29 lacs from the him, but now he has refused to return the same. He has also sold the tractor of the petitioner without his consent and has retained whole of the amount with him. When the petitioner demanded back his money, respondent No.4 gave beatings and threatened to kill him. He has also thrown him out of his house. In this regard, a representation dated 21.07.2014 (Annexure P-3) has been made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving a direction to the Senior Superintendent of

Police, Ferozepur-respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 21.07.2014 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously and take action in accordance with law.
