HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The only claim in this petition is that a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to strictly comply with the provisions of section 160 Cr.P.C. in case the presence of the petitioner is required in connection with any investigation/inquiry.

It is stated that respondent No.4, who is a married lady has been submitting false complaint to the police against the petitioner with a view to create trouble in the life of the petitioner, regarding which he is being summoned un-necessarily to the police station time and again. It is further stated that the marriage of the petitioner is fixed in the near future and the complaints have been moved by the complainant with a view to cause hindrance in the said marriage.

Taking into consideration the limited prayer in this petition, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 that when the petitioner is required by the police in connection with any complaint/investigation, section 160 Cr.P.C. be strictly complied with.

Ordered accordingly.
