Petitioner has filed a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, Annexure P-6, for registration of case against the police officials alleging that an attempt had been made to dispossess the petitioner from the tenanted premises by the private respondents. Through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. direction has been sought for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members besides a direction to the police authorities to take a decision on representation Annexure P-6.

Learned State counsel on the instructions from ASI Sulakhan Singh, informs that the representation has been inquired into and filed.

After going through the detailed reply of the official respondents, it appears that there is a dispute regarding tenant and landlord. Civil litigation appears to have been filed by the petitioner against the tenant-private respondents. The landlord has also filed ejectment proceedings against the petitioner's son.

In view of the said circumstances, there is no ground to issue any direction to the State authorities. However, it is observed that in case of any

apprehension of breach of peace and imminent threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, it will be open to her to approach the police authorities expecting that the genuineness of the allegations would be fairly looked into to determine the breach of peace and to ensure the protection of life and liberty of any one aggrieved.

Disposed of in the above terms.
