Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the present petition has become infructuous qua petitioners No.1 and 2, namely, Gurlal Singh and Gurpreet Singh as they have been arrested. As regards petitioner No.3 Gursharan Singh, he submits that pursuant to order dated 9.7.2015, he has joined the investigation and has appeared before the investigating officer on 13.7.2015.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of petitioner No.3 Gursharan Singh is not required.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by this Court to petitioner No.3 vide order dated 7.4.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner No.3 shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
