ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (Oral)

Sunita Rani and Gurpreet Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.6 and 7 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.6 and 7. They have not placed on record any document showing that they have got married. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 22.06.2015 to respondents no.2 and 4.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No.4- Commissioner of Police, Patiala, to decide the representation of

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the petitioners, within a period of one month and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
