Marriage certificate has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Both the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major and seek protection as they apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 to 7.

Petitioner No.1 is Christian. It has been pleaded that petitioner no.1 is converted to Hindu but there is no material to support this fact.

Without commending on the validity of the marriage, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No. 2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-4 within a period of one month and grant the protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
