Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.192 dated 23.5.2014 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Sector-7, Faridabad.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the complainant jointly pray for allowing the present petition, contending that in compliance of the order dated 8.7.2014, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.
