Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.54 dated 09.05.2015, under Sections 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 01.07.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner pleads that petitioner was not apprehended on the spot. He has been falsely implicated by the police. Earlier a false case was registered against his father. He is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 14.08.2015.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he will be admitted to the interim anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer on the conditions

that he will join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer, that he will not directly or indirectly tamper with the prosecution evidence and that he will not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Vijay Kumar has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 01.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
