CRM-21982 of 2015

This is an application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by learned counsel for the petitioner for placing on record copy of judgment dated 09.01.1988, Medical Reports and Medical opinion as Annexures P-5, P-6 and P-7 respectively.

Application is allowed, Annexures P-5 to P-7 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-20570 of 2015

This is an application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by learned counsel for respondent No.2 for placing on record reply on behalf of respondent No.2.

Application is allowed, reply is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-20571 of 2015

This is an application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to allow the complainant to become party as respondent No.2.

Application is allowed, as prayed for.

CRM-M-20759 of 2015

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 50 dated 03.06.2015, under Sections 376, 354A (1) (2) and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station, Haryana, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard the submissions made by Mr. R.S. Rai, Sr. Advocate representing the petitioner and Mr. Ashish Sanghi, DAG, Punjab representing the State; Mr. D.S. Pheruman, Advocate representing complainant-respondent No.2.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 09.07.2015, it was submitted by learned State counsel that DDR No.27 dated 10.06.2015 had been recorded deleting Section 376 IPC from the case. Today, he submits that final report deleting the said Section has been prepared and is to be filed in the Court after approval by the concerned authorities

The petitioner is stated to be 86 years old and a heart patient. His medical certificates etc. have also been placed on file. He is in custody since 04.06.2015.

After submission of the charge-sheet the trial is likely to take

some time, whereas there appears no plausible ground to detain the petitioner in custody. Accordingly, he is admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.
