This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further to ensure that they may not be harassed by respondents No. 4 to 6. Petitioner No.1 Geeta Rani has been produced by Head Constable Padam Singh with Kailash CHG

On instructions from ASI Balbeer Singh, learned State counsel submits that in pursuance of notice sent by this Court the parents (respondents No.4 and 5) of petitioner No.1 had appeared before ASI Balbeer Singh and had got recorded their statements, wherein they have stated that they have no objection to the marriage of their daughter with petitioner No.2-Ankur.

It is also submitted that the parents of petitioner No.2-Ankur had also appeared before ASI Balbeer Singh and had made

statement consenting to the marriage. When the parents of the petitioners have consented to the marriage the petitioners should feel no danger to their life at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

In any case petitioner No.1 Geeta Rani is allowed to leave the protection home and a direction is given to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala that in case the petitioners move an application before him seeking protection for their life and liberty, he will look into the matter and provide necessary protection to them, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

Disposed of .
