Learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated at the bar that Insurance Company is ready to pay ₹1,00,000/- more in addition to the amount awarded by the Tribunal without interest. However, in case the Insurance company fails to pay the above said amount within a period of two months, it may be liable to pay interest.

Learned counsel for the appellant has accepted the said offer.

In these circumstances, the appeal stands partly accepted. The Insurance company is directed to pay a sum of ₹1,00,000/- more in addition to the amount already awarded by the Tribunal within two months from today, failing which, the Insurance Company shall be liable to pay interest @ 7.5% per annum.
