The State was directed to furnish status report regarding the investigation.

On the instructions from ASI Chand Singh it has been informed that cancellation report has been prepared and submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate in the month of November, 2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have not received any notice from the Court in this regard.

Copy of the cancellation report has been placed on record.

The petitioners have got alternative remedy of filing a protest petition or to file a private complaint.

Without prejudice to the right of the petitioners to avail any of the legal remedies, this petition is disposed of as having rendered

infructuous. All the pleas taken up in this petition can be raised in the proceedings in the protest petition or in the complaint if advised so.

Disposal of this petition will not in any manner prejudice the rights of the petitioners to file protest petition or to file a private complaint.

It will be open to the Illaqa Magistrate to accept the cancellation report or to reject the cancellation report or to consider the protest petition as a private complaint or to order further investigation in accordance with the judgment of Supreme Court in **Abhinandan Jha and others Vs. State of Bihar and another 1995 (3) SCR 864.**
