MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 177 dated 27.11.2014 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at P.S.Nurpur Bedi, District Ropar.

It had been contended before this Court that there was an exchange of disputed land between the grandfather/father of the petitioners and the complainant in which some mistake crept in the revenue record.

Noticing as above and also lack of mafa fides this Court had granted interim protection to the petitioners vide its order dated 18.2.2015 subject to the compliance of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Report regarding culpability of the petitioners was also sought.

Be that as it may, the petitioners have joined investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh.

Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation to the

satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 18.2.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioners continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
