The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing First Information Report No.265 dated 15.09.2013 under Sections 419/420/465/467/468/471/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he is the person who procured conspirators Gurnam Singh and Surjit Singh. He had not signed or attested the sale deed allegedly forged by impersonating the vendors.

The submissions made by learned counsel representing the petitioner and learned counsel representing the State of Punjab have been considered.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that Jagjit Singh, the main beneficiary in the deed has already been granted bail vide order dated 23.06.2015. The petitioner is in custody since 16.04.2014. The trial of the case is still likely to take some time and there appears no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody. He is admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Area Magistrate/Trial Court, Ludhiana.
